

Coastal Cities Conference Call – Information Summary July 29, 2010

Miami-Dade County has not been impacted by oil product from the Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill Incident.

- Incident Information
 - There has been no oil discharged into the Gulf of Mexico since July 15, 2010.

 - More than **24,800** personnel are working the on and offshore response for the Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill Incident
 - Nearly **34.7** million gallons of oil-water mix have been recovered
 - Response Vessels Available: **4,200**
 - Response Aircraft Available: **114**
 - More than **1.84** million gallons of dispersant have been deployed
 - There is no planned use of dispersants in Florida waters
 - Vessels of Opportunity: **166 (none in South Florida)**
 - BP claims in Florida total **34,431** with approximately **\$47,758,093.31** paid.
 - Only Louisiana is projected to be impacted in the next 72 hour period
 - 88% of all boom in Florida is expected to be removed in the next 3 weeks
- Miami-Dade County Deepwater Horizon Response
 - Planning
 - Miami Dade County Department of Emergency Management has develop a Deepwater Horizon Contingency Response Plan. This plan includes:
 - EOC Response Table of Organization
 - Baseline Assessment Plan by Miami-Dade DERM
 - Department Roles and Responsibilities
 - Oil Product Reporting, Notification, and Collection Protocol
 - Tar Ball Reporting Fact Sheet
 - Volunteer Recruitment, Training, and Utilization Plan
 - Volunteer Training Power Point Presentation
 - Guidance on the BP Claims Process
 - Weekly Situation Reports
 - Listing of Qualified County Vendors
 - The Department of Emergency Management (DEM) continues to monitor Federal and State activity in regards to the event. This includes soliciting and reviewing federal, state, and local plans, coordinating information and tracking the oil plume.
 - DEM will continue to distribute weekly Situation Reports to ensure that consistent information is being received by all partner agencies
 - Municipalities seeking reimbursement from BP should reference the *BP Claims Process Guidelines* which is attached to this email.

- Miami-Dade County is not expecting to receive an applicant briefing anytime in the near future
